Hagan Scholars from 43 states currently attend 358 colleges and universities.

Recipients must graduate college in four years or less, and work 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year.

The program has been continuously expanded, a result of compelling essays by students overcoming adversity.

2017 - Nationwide: All public high schools located in counties having fewer than 50,000 residents.

2020 - Added 1,327 remote rural schools located in counties having more than 50,000 residents.
