General Information

This fall, Hagan Scholars from 46 states will attend 409 colleges and universities.

Scholarship recipients must graduate college in four years, and work 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year.

The program has been continuously expanded, a result of compelling essays by high ability students having substantial financial need.

2020 - Added 1,327 remote rural schools located in counties having more than 50,000 residents.
