

## The Hagan Scholarship

### Tips on how to submit a successful application:

1. Follow the Instructions when completing the Online Form and when preparing and assembling the Application Attachment PDF. Incomplete submittals are not processed.
2. The Essay and Four-Year Plan are important documents; these documents provide an opportunity for you to distinguish yourself from other high achieving applicants.
3. All documents and the photo must be clear; not fuzzy, difficult to read or see.
4. Double-check your work and confirm the correct PDF has been uploaded to the application.
5. Complete the FAFSA now, it may take several days to obtain the SAR and your EFC. Applicants must be Pell Grant eligible.

The mean disbursement for Hagan Scholars who have graduated college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program is over \$34,000; \$24,000 to attend college and \$10,000 from managing their Schwab Investment Account and Study Abroad. Most Hagan Scholars graduate college debt-free. Prioritize your Time and make the most of this once in a life-time opportunity by submitting the best application you can.

A high percentage of eligible applicants are awarded scholarships. The Application Deadline is December 1, 2021.
