### General Information

Hagan Scholars have attended 429 colleges and universities located in 48 states. Number of scholarships awarded to date 2,933.

Hagan Scholars must maintain a four year graduation schedule, maintain a 3.25 CGPA, and work 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year.

### Historical Growth of the Scholarship Program

2008 - Hagan Scholarship Foundation Established (after several years of preparation)

2010 - Missouri, first applications received.

2017 - Nationwide. All public high schools located in counties having fewer than 50,000 residents.

2022 - All public high schools located in cities and towns having fewer than 25,000 residents and whose outer boundary does not abut another city or town.
