

## **Hagan Scholarship Foundation Graduate Scholarship Particulars**

Hagan Scholarship recipients who have graduated college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program, fulfilled ALL scholarship, workshop, and Schwab Account responsibilities, and have achieved a 3.75 CGPA can apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship.

Recipients of a graduate scholarship must provide an Official Graduation Plan prepared by the Institution and signed by the Department Chair. The Plan must outline the graduation requirements for the intended graduate or professional degree. Recipients must earn 12 hours of degree applicable credits as outlined in the Graduation Plan each semester. Recipients must enroll in graduate school the first semester following the award of their undergraduate degree. Recipients must maintain a 3.50 CGPA.

The Hagan Graduate Scholarship will provide Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) each semester for up to four consecutive semesters, fall and spring semesters only. If on a tri-semester or quarter semester Six Thousand Dollars (\$6,000) will be disbursed at the time normal semester disbursements are made.
