### **Graduate Scholarship Particulars**

Hagan Scholarship recipients who have graduated college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program and have fulfilled ALL Scholarship, Workshop and Schwab Account responsibilities, and have achieved a 3.75 CGPA, can apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship. The Hagan Graduate Scholarship is good for up to four additional consecutive semesters in college. The Hagan Graduate Scholarship provides up to \$7,500 each fall and spring semester. Quarter and Tri-semester school disbursements are made when two semester school disbursements are made.

**Applicants must apply for a Graduate Scholarship in the last semester of college prior to receiving their undergraduate degree, by December 1 or May 1 whichever is applicable**, using the [Link](#) provided by HSF and posted on the Portal Homepage. Recipients of a Graduate Scholarship must enroll in graduate school the first semester following receipt of their undergraduate degree.

### **Application, Academic, and Submittal Information**

#### Application Information

Official Graduation Plan prepared by the Institution and signed by the Department Chair. The Plan must outline the Graduation Requirements and provide a Timeline for earning the intended degree, compliant with the Academic Responsibilities listed below.

#### Academic Responsibilities

1. Recipients must earn 12 hours of applicable credits each semester.
2. All classes must be seated on-campus classes unless waived by HSF.
3. Recipients must achieve a 3.25 GPA each semester.
4. Recipients must maintain a 3.50 CGPA.
