Overview of Hagan Graduate Scholarship

Hagan Scholarship recipients who are eligible and have fulfilled ALL Scholarship, Workshop and Schwab Account responsibilities, and have achieved a 3.75 CGPA, can apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship. The Hagan Graduate Scholarship is good for up to four additional consecutive semesters in college, providing up to \$7,500 each semester.

Applicants must apply for a Graduate Scholarship during the last semester of college prior to receiving their undergraduate degree, by December 1 or May 1 whichever is applicable, or after completing the number of credits hours required for the equivalent of an undergraduate degree if in a professional program requiring more than four years of college. Recipients of a Graduate Scholarship must enroll in graduate school at an eligible institution the first semester following eligibility.

Notable Particulars

1. Graduate Scholarship Application:

1. Must provide an Official Graduation Plan prepared by the Institution and signed by the Department Chair. The Graduation Plan must outline the Graduation Requirements and provide a Timeline for earning the intended degree.
2. Must provide a complete copy of applicant's current Official Grade Transcript.

2. Graduate School Academic Responsibilities:

1. Must earn 12 hours of applicable credits each semester, fall and spring.
2. Must be seated on-campus classes. Online classes must have HSF prior written approval.
3. Must achieve a 3.25 GPA each semester.
4. Must maintain a 3.50 CGPA.
5. Must maintain the Graduation Schedule approved when awarded the scholarship.

4. Recipients Paid Bill or Invoice for the current semester
5. List of Enrolled Courses and Credit Hours*
6. List of ALL Scholarships, Awards, Grants, Waivers, Financial Aid*
7. FERPA Agreement*
8. Graduate Scholarship Agreement*
9. Current Official Grade Transcript
10. Employment Report Documenting 240 hours of work each year from January 1 until commencement of that year's fall semester in college (Fall semester only)*
11. Personal Financial Statement (Fall semester only)*
12. Annual Progress Report (Fall semester only)*
13. Graduation Essay*
