Hagan Scholars must maintain a four year or less graduation schedule, maintain a 3.25 CGPA, and work 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year in college.

2008 - Hagan Scholarship Foundation Established

2011 - First scholarships awarded. Missouri only.

2017 - Nationwide. All public high schools located in counties having fewer than 50,000 residents.

2022 - Nationwide. All traditional public high schools governed by a school district.
