



Expedited Inaugural Timeline

For the 2024-2025 Academic Year

1. The Scholarship Application can be downloaded from the HSF website after November 1, 2024.
2. Submittal Deadline December 1, 2024.
3. Applications processed and scholarships awarded by January 1, 2025.
4. Scholarship disbursements will be retroactive to include the 2024 fall semester in college.

Eligibility Requirements

1. Must be a foreign citizen.
2. Must have graduated college for the first time in 2024 in a foreign country.
3. Must be currently enrolled in graduate school or a post baccalaureate professional program in the United States.
4. Must be fluent in the English language, and must provide a copy of applicant's English proficiency test results.
5. Must maintain the full-time Graduation Schedule prepared by the institution and approved by the Department Chair and HSF.
6. Must have worked 240 hours from January 1, 2024 to September 1, 2024. Employment and/or paid internships must have been performed under supervision for compensation. Work can be full-time or part-time, or a combination of the two.
7. Applicant's Parents Gross Household Income for 2023 must not have exceeded \$100,000 or the U.S. dollar equivalent.
8. Must not have been convicted of a crime.

Hagan International Scholarship 2024-2025

The Hagan International Scholarship is a new worldwide competitive scholarship for international students who received their first undergraduate degree in 2024 in a foreign country. Applicants must be enrolled as a full-time student in graduate school or a post baccalaureate professional program in the United States.

The scholarship provides up to \$7,500 each semester for up to four consecutive semesters and can be used to obtain a graduate degree or to help pay for the first two years of a professional degree requiring more than two years of college.

A Free Workshop provides recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum.

Hagan Scholars have attended 637 colleges and universities located in 49 states and the District of Columbia.

Purpose

The Purpose of the Hagan International Scholarship is to provide each recipient with the opportunity to obtain a graduate degree from a U.S college or university. And, to provide each recipient with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum.

Recipient Responsibilities

1. Must achieve a 3.25 GPA each semester.
2. Must maintain a 3.50 CGPA after the first semester.
3. Must maintain the full-time Graduation Schedule prepared by the institution and approved by HSF.

To be fair to all recipients we will not make exceptions to the Scholarship Criteria or to Submittal Deadlines.



Scholarship Particulars

1. The scholarship disbursement amount, up to \$7,500 each semester, will be determined by HSF by taking the Total Cost of Attendance including tuition, fees, room, board, books, supplies, personal and transportation costs; then deducting the total dollar amount of ALL scholarships, awards, grants, waivers, and institution provided work study.
2. The disbursement amount will be adjusted each semester to offset the expiration or loss of other scholarships, awards, grants, waivers, or institution work-study.
3. The scholarship is renewable for up to three additional consecutive semesters if the recipient fulfills the scholarship criteria and mandatory workshop responsibilities.
4. First year recipients will receive \$2,000 to purchase essential items for college not covered by the scholarship; such as a computer, printer, cell phone, clothing, bedding, and office supplies.
5. There is no application fee or processing fee.

Historical Information

The Hagan Scholarship Foundation was established in 2008. Hagan Scholarships have been awarded since 2011. To date, 4,509 Hagan Scholarships have been awarded to students attending high schools located in the United States. Hagan Scholars who graduate college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program are eligible to apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship, good for up to four additional semesters in college to attend graduate school or used to help pay for the first two years of a professional program.

The Hagan International Scholarship is a new competitive scholarship for international students, similar to the Hagan Graduate Scholarship. Applicants must have received their first undergraduate degree in 2024 in a foreign country, and be currently enrolled in graduate school or a post baccalaureate professional program in the United States.

The Hagan International Scholarship

1. \$2,000 to purchase items for college.
 2. Up to \$7,500 each semester for up to four consecutive semesters, or \$30,000.
 3. A Free Workshop to learn important life skills not typically covered in the college curriculum.
 4. Recipients must contribute toward the cost of their education by working 240 hours from January 1 to September 1, prior to the start of the fall semester of each academic year.
