Eligibility Criteria

1. Must not hold U.S. citizenship.
2. Must be a first-time graduate student enrolling in the Fall26 semester. Must not have attended graduate school.
3. Must not be over 24 years of age as of the May 1, 2026 Submittal Deadline.
4. Must have been awarded or will be awarded by the upcoming Fall26 semester an undergraduate degree from a foreign institution.
5. Must provide a Graduation Plan for the intended degree prepared by an eligible Institution located in the United States and approved by the Department Chair.
6. Must provide a Letter of Acceptance for Enrollment for the upcoming Fall26 semester from the Institution.
7. Must provide a copy of applicant's undergraduate Transcript showing the Award Degree with the Fall26 Semester Submittal.
8. Must be fluent in the English language.
9. Must contribute toward the cost of applicant's education by working 240 hours from January 1 to September 1, 2026 prior to the start of the fall semester. Employment and/or paid internships must be performed under supervision for compensation. Work can be full-time or part-time.
10. Must provide a copy of the parents Financial Statement using a Form provided by HSF.

Hagan International Scholarship 2026-2027

The Hagan International Scholarship is a worldwide competitive scholarship for first-time graduate students.

Applicants must not hold U.S. citizenship, must not be over 24 years of age as of the Submittal Deadline, must have graduated or will graduate from a foreign institution, and must have received an acceptance letter for the upcoming fall semester from a college or university located in the U.S.

The scholarship provides up to \$7,500 each semester for up to four consecutive semesters to obtain a graduate degree or to help pay for the first two years of a professional program.

A Free Workshop to provides recipients with a practical understanding of important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum: How to Invest and how to prepare a Plan for Retirement.

Purpose

The Purpose of the Hagan International Scholarship is to provide recipients with the opportunity to attend graduate school at a U.S college or university. And, to learn important life skills not typically covered in the school curriculum.

Recipient Responsibilities

1. Must achieve a 3.25 GPA each semester.
2. Must maintain a 3.50 CGPA after the first semester.
3. Must maintain the Graduation Schedule prepared by the institution and approved by the Department Chair.

To be fair to all recipients we will not make exceptions to the Scholarship Criteria or Submittal Deadlines.

Scholarship Particulars

1. The scholarship disbursement, up to \$7,500 each semester, will be determined by HSF by taking the Total Cost of Attendance including tuition, fees, room, board, books, supplies, personal and transportation costs; then deducting the total dollar amount of ALL scholarships, awards, grants, waivers, and institution provided work study.
2. The disbursement amount will be adjusted each semester to offset the expiration or loss of other scholarships, awards, grants, waivers, or institution provided work-study.
3. The scholarship is renewable for up to three additional consecutive semesters if the recipient fulfills the scholarship criteria and workshop responsibilities.
4. First year recipients will receive \$2,000 to purchase essential items for college such as a computer, printer, cell phone, clothing, bedding, and office supplies.
5. There is no application fee or processing fee.

Historical Information

The Hagan Scholarship Foundation was established in 2008. To date, 5,594 scholarships have been awarded. The Hagan Scholarship is a need-based merit scholarship. Hagan Scholars have attended 769 colleges and universities located in 50 states and the District of Columbia. Hagan Scholars who graduate college while in the Hagan Scholarship Program can apply for a Hagan Graduate Scholarship, good for up to four additional consecutive semesters to attend graduate school or a professional program.

Hagan International Scholarship

The Hagan International Scholarship is similar to the Hagan Graduate Scholarship. The intended recipient is a high achieving goal-driven student having substantial financial need.

1. \$2,000 to purchase items for college.
 2. Up to \$7,500 each semester for up to four consecutive semesters, or \$30,000.
