General Information

- Hagan Scholars have attended 745+ colleges and universities in all 50 states and the District of Columbia, and graduate schools in the United States through the International Graduate Scholarship.
- Undergraduate scholars must complete their degree within four years, maintain a 3.25 CGPA, and work a minimum of 240 hours prior to the start of each academic year.

Program History

2008 Hagan Scholarship Foundation established.

2011 First scholarships awarded (33) to recipients attending public high schools in rural Missouri counties; subsequently expanded to additional states.

2017 Nationwide. Recipients attended public high schools in rural counties with fewer than 50,000 residents.

2024 Nationwide. Recipients attended public, private, charter, magnet, and STEM high schools located in the United States.

2025 International Graduate Scholarships. A worldwide need-based merit scholarship for international students to attend graduate school in the United States.
